The Assam Women's University, (AWU) Jorhat is the first Women's University in the entire North-East India established with the aim of providing a level playing ground for the women with respect to accessing higher education for promoting their knowledge, skill, and competitiveness in different spheres of social and scientific fields located in the city of Jorhat, popularly known as the 'knowledge city of Assam'. The university is dedicated to the task of creating a strong platform for the women of Assam in particular as well as in national and international dimensions. The university is devoted to providing best-in-class education to the students, making them highly competitive and fairly efficient in all spheres of life. The university promotes innovative and confidence-building activities among the students, preparing them to reap the benefits of 21st century knowledge and the blooming industrial revolution of the globe.

The genesis of Assam Women's University

The University started functioning from the month of September 2014. The University has been established by an Act (XXII) of 2013 of State Legislature of Assam as a State University vide Notification LGL.149/2011/92 dated 21.08.2013 for establishing a teaching, residential type, non-affiliating women's university and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its own departments vide letter No F.9-18/2014 (CPP-I/PU) dated the 12th December 2014 and included in the UGC list of State Universities.

Objectives

- To provide for facilities and offer opportunities to women for post-graduate education in applied science, arts, technology, industry, commerce, management, and social science by instruction, training, research, development, and extension and by such other means as the University may deem fit.
- To promote research in applied science and arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science for the advancement of knowledge

and for the betterment of the society particularly with a focus on women's perspective.

- To device and implement programs of education for women in applied sciences, arts, technology, industry, commerce, management and social science that are relevant to the changing socio-economic needs of the society, in terms of breadth of diversity and depth of specialization.
- To serve as a center for fostering cooperation and exchange of ideas between the academic and research community on the one hand and industry on the other hand.
- Organize exchange programs with other institutions of repute into India and abroad with a view to keep abreast of the latest developments in relevant areas of teaching and research.

Mission:

Educational and skill empowerment of young women of the state, the region, and the country by imparting intellectual and value-based education and to prepare the women force for social and economic transformation through the medium of science, commerce, humanity, etc. knowledge channels and skills therein.

Goal:

The ultimate goal of the University is to produce 21st-century women knowledge and think tanks to effectively carry forward the women-centric opportunities in the state of Assam and to become a matching partner in the national and global development paradigm. 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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of **ASSAM WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY, ROWRIAH, JORHAT - 785004** which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2022, the statement of Income and Expenditure and the statement of Receipts and Payments for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial performance and cash flows of the University in accordance with the Accounting Standards. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material mis-statements.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend upon the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the University's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Opinion

In our opinion and to the best of our information and to the explanations given to us and subject to the observations that *no provision has been made in the Annual Accounts towards gratuity payable to employees* and also subject to our comments, observations and



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qualifications in the Audit Report as per Annexure - I, the financial statements give the information required in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- a) In the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the University as at 31st March 2022, the statement of Income and Expenditures, of its excess of income over expenditures for the year then ended and also the statement of Receipts and Payments, of the financial transactions for the year ended on 31st March, 2022.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

1. Further we report that,

- (a) We have sought and obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit.
- (b) In our opinion proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the University so far as it appears from our examination of those books;
- (c) The Balance Sheet, the statement of Income and Expenditures and the statement of Receipts and Payments dealt with by this Report are in agreement with the books of account;
- (d) With respect to the adequacy of the internal financial controls over financial reporting of the Company and the operating effectiveness of such controls, refer to para (ix) in "Annexure - I."

(Annexure – I – Referred to in Paragraph 6 of our audit report of even date

i) Commencement of the University

Assam Women University came into existence by an Act passed in the State Assembly of Assam (Assam Act No. XXII of 2013) in 2013, which received the assent of the Governor on 12th August, 2013, and was later notified in Assam Gazette on 21st August, 2013.

The University started its formal operations on and from 11th September, 2014.

ii) In respect of its fixed assets

- a) The state Government of Assam, by memo no. RSS.1031/2011/Pt./39, dated 1st September, 2015, allotted Govt. land measuring 73 (seventy-three) Bighas – 4 (four) Kathas – 6 (six) Lechas in Sensowa Gaon under Charaibahi Mouza of Jorhat West Revenue Circle, *free of cost*, in favour of Assam Women University.

Out of above, the University is in physical possession of 49 (forty-nine) Bighas 2 (two) Kathas 1 (one) Lechas as per report No. J.W.C: - 1207, dated 14.05.2015 of the Circle Officer, Jorhat West Revenue Circle, Jorhat.

- b) Further vide memo no. JRS78/2014/88, dated 06.01.2022, of the Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat, the state Govt. of Assam, further allotted land measuring 10 (ten) Bighas – 1 (one) Katha -- 12 (twelve) Lechas in Sensowa Gaon under Charaibahi Mouza of Jorhat West Revenue Circle, *free of cost*, in favour of Assam Women University.

The University physical possession of entire 10 (ten) Bighas – 1 (one) Katha -- 12 (twelve) Lechas as per report No. J.W.C: - 10/2071/185, dated 02.02.2022 of the Circle Officer, Jorhat West Revenue Circle, Jorhat.

Since the accounts are prepared on historical cost basis as per Indian GAAP, the market value of these lands has not been incorporated in the accounts, as no costs have been incurred on acquisition of these lands.



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- c) Similarly, the University took possession 4 (four) existing buildings, free of costs, on the above lands, specified as under.
- RCC 3 (three) storied building (presently used as Academic-cum-Administrative Block)
 - Assam Type Building (Presently used as auditorium, class room and for central library)
 - RCC Building
 - RCC 2 (two) storied building – 3 (three) nos. – (Presently used as hostel).

No acquisition costs have been incurred for the above buildings.

As per requests of the University, market value of the above buildings is arrived by the Executive Engineer, PWD, Jorhat Building Division, vide their memo no. JBD/TECH/VAL/06(A)/2010/696, dated 29.05.2015, which is as under.

- RCC 3 (three) storied building (presently used as Academic-cum-Administrative Block) – Rs. 23,525,000.00
- Assam Type Building (Presently used as auditorium, class room and for central library) – Rs. 11,824,000.00
- RCC Building – Rs. 19,272,800.00
- RCC 2 (two) stories building – 3 (three) nos. – (Presently used as hostel) – Rs. 33,380,400.00

Totalling – Rs. 88,002,200.00 (Rupees Eight crores eighty lakh two thousand two hundred) only.

Since the accounts are prepared on historical cost basis, the market value of these lands has not been incorporated in the accounts, as no costs have been incurred on acquisition of these lands, as per Indian GAAP.

- d) The University has not maintained proper records showing full particulars including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets in respect of moveable/immovable assets. However, a stock book is maintained showing details of fixed assets purchased during the year under audit. It is recommended that fixed assets register in proper format should be maintained showing details of assets and its location. It University had assured that fixed assets register in proper format will be introduced from the next financial year.
- d) Fixed assets have been not been physically verified at the end of the year. It is however submitted that steps have been taken to regularize this matter from the next financial year.



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- e) The University has not disposed off any part of fixed assets during the year, so there is no perceivable effect on the going concern.

iii) In respect of accounting system employed

The University has followed double entry systems accounting on Cash basis as against mandated accrual system of accounting. Liabilities incurred and incomes accrued during the year have been accounted for on Cash basis and *not on accrual basis*. Liabilities are paid as and when they arise. It is submitted that the University does not have substantial liability at the year-end except for a few advertisement and professional fee bills, etc. It is submitted by the University that it will migrate to accrual basis of accounting once it starts operating in full-fledged way.

iv) In respect of Opening and Closing Fund Positions

The Opening Balance of Rs. 434.86 lakhs as on 01.04.2021 and the Closing Balance of Rs. 480.04 lakhs as on 31.03.2022, represent the true picture of the Fund position of the University and reflect correctly the Funds held by the University in bank accounts.

v) In respect of Diversion of Funds

During the period under audit, there has been no diversion of funds to and from State grants.

vi) In respect accounting method followed

The University has been maintaining accounts in the Double Entry System, showing detail nature of accounts.

vii) In respect of functional classification of expenses

Expenses in the Annual Accounts are booked on the basis cost center, viz., Departments. Functional classification of expenses, like Establishment, Traveling, Contingencies, Non-Recurring Expenses, etc., would provide more meaningful representation of accounting information for control purposes.

viii) In respect of its inventories

- a) The inventories have not been physically verified by the management during the year at reasonable intervals.



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- b) In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us, the procedures of physical verification of inventory followed by the management are not reasonable and adequate in relation to the size of the University and the nature of its operations.
- c) The University has maintained proper records of inventory. No discrepancies were reported since no physical verifications were undertaken. It is, as such not known, whether the inventory exists as per records.
- ix) In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us, there are adequate internal control procedures commensurate with the size of the University and the nature of its operations for the purchase of inventory and fixed assets.
- x) The University has not taken any loans from bank or other financial Institutions during the year.
- xi) According to the information and explanations given to us in respect of statutory and other dues, the University has generally been regular in depositing undisputed statutory dues including Professional Taxes, TDS, etc.
- xi) **Frauds during the year**

As reported to us, no frauds were detected during the year under audit.
